This Samsung MI 1660 V 35 Reset guide will help you reset the printer to factory settings in order to remove any unwanted data or settings. If your Samsung MI 1660 V 35 is not printing properly, it might be due to a setting that was changed by accident. Some possible reasons are when something is printed, the document would come out blank or when prints are faded when they should be black. To fix this problem, you need to reset the printer back to its original settings prior to these issues happening in order for it print correctly again. This guide will show you how...

This guide will also show you how you can find out what has been set up on your printer before resetting it. This is helpful because some data will not be erased if the settings has been used before. To do this, follow these simple steps.

1.) Turn off your printer and make sure the power cord is unplugged from the wall outlet. 2.) Unplug all cables from the printer, make sure they are out of its ports. 3.) Open the top cover of your printer to see what setting you should reset to factory default.

4.) Now carefully turn on your printer by plugging in one by one its back, front and power cables to ensure that each light on it goes off after each connection. If this happens, you have successfully reset it back to its factory settings.

What are the Issues/Problems that Samsung MI 1660 V 35 Reset might fix?

Below is the troubleshooting steps for Samsung MI 1660 V 35. If these steps do not solve your issue, you might have to go for a more complicated solution.

1.) Make sure the power cord is securely plugged in to the wall outlet. 2.) Check to see if the USB cable is securely plugged in to the printer's USB port so it can be recognized by Windows 10 when you are trying to print from another computer. If it says that it has not been recognized by Windows, there could be a problem with your printer setup or your USB port on your PC. 3.) To make sure that the ink cartridges are installed in the printer, try to print a test page. 4.) Make sure the power switch on the printer is in the "on" position. 5.) Make sure all cables are securely plugged in.

If neither of these steps solve your problem, you might have to go for a more complicated solution. The more complicated solution will require you to reset your Samsung MI 1660 V 35 using its factory settings, which is only possible if you have experienced any of these machine errors before:

1.) All cartridges are correctly installed in their slots and ink level is at its lowest point. 2.) The paper is not installed correctly. 3.) Your printer is out of paper or toner.

How to Reset Samsung MI 1660 V 35 to Factory Settings Using a USB Cable: (Steps) 1.) Make sure the printer is connected to a power supply and turned on. 2.) Open [Control Panel > Device and Printers]. 3.) Right click on your printer icon and choose "Printing Preferences" 4.) When the window opens, go ahead and click on the [Maintenance] tab at the top. 5.) Under "Maintenance Mode," make sure "Yes" is selected for "Maintenance Printing Wait Time." 6.
